

## GBC Board of Directors Meeting

July 18, 2009

--Holter Monitor—No one has used the monitor in several months. A new Digital Monitor will cost the club \$1,500. Club revenues are in a declining trend. Several members have purchased their own monitors for usage. UGA veterinary school and Alba Corporation will still read our analog system. Recommendation by the committee is not to purchase a new digital monitor at this time. The Board voted unanimously not to purchase the monitor.

--The Fall 2010 show date has been moved to the 42<sup>nd</sup> week, which is in October. The show is presently held the third Thursday in September. The Kennesaw show remains at the current date which is only one week after the new date for the Atlanta show.

--It was announced that the Augusta Kennel Club is pulling out of the Combined Specialty shows in April at the Perry, Ga. show-site. Their date will be assumed by the Valdosta Kennel Club which will now have two shows in the Perry, Ga. (Peach Blossom Cluster). Valdosta will receive only one day's money from the cluster however, because they are giving up their stand-alone show in Valdosta. In other words, the money will now be a 3 way split, instead of four.

Entry fees have been set at \$27 for dogs and bitches, \$18 for puppies and \$5 for Jr. Showmanship. If the cluster picks up our judge they will pay them \$350 plus \$3 per dog after 50.
