Treasurers Report

I got a check for the final October show settlement yesterday - \$336.00. I was surprised we got anything, since the entry was only 28. I paid \$50 to Cheryl for gas, \$100 to ABCF in her name in lieu of judging fee, and \$100 for hospitality, so we made a profit of \$86 on the show.

Also, it was my understanding that we simply renew our membership in the Boxer Charitable Health Foundation (\$25), not make an additional donation. Am I incorrect?

With the Fall Cluster picking up our judge for the remainder of that weekend, our Fall 2014 show expenses should be limited to Hospitality.

Balance in treasury as of **10/31/13** is \$4394.06. (with \$850.25 of that amount designated for Rescue).
